HOUSE BILL NO. 862

1	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT
2	AUTHORITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING A STUDY TO DETERMINE IF THERE
3	IS A STATISTICAL DISPARITY IN THE NUMBER OF MINORITY CONTRACTORS
4	DOING BUSINESS WITH THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
5	2005.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much of it as may be
- 8 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
- 9 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi Development
- 10 Authority for the purpose of funding a study to determine if there
- 11 is a statistical disparity in the number of minority contractors
- 12 doing business with the State of Mississippi, as required by
- 13 Section 57-1-57, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year
- 14 beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005.....\$150,000.00.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
- 16 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund
- 17 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
- 18 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his
- 19 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or
- 20 officers in the manner provided by law.
- 21 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after July 1, 2004.
