8	SECTION 1. Section 21-9-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

10	21-9-25. The first city council elected under the provisions
11	of this chapter shall at its first meeting employ by majority vote
12	of all its members a city manager who shall be the chief
13	administrative officer of the city. The manager shall receive
14	such compensation as the council shall determine. The person
15	employed as city manager shall hold at least a bachelor's degree
16	from an accredited college or university and shall have
17	knowledgeable experience in any of the following fields: work
18	projection, budget planning, accounting, purchasing, cost control
19	personnel management and road construction procedures. City
20	managers appointed before July 1, 2004, shall not be required to
21	meet the qualifications stated in this section as a condition of
22	continued employment. The person employed as city manager shall
23	not engage in any other business or profession so long as he $\underline{\text{or}}$
24	she shall hold the office of city manager. No person elected to
25	the city council shall be eligible for the office of city manager
26	during the term for which he was elected.
27	If the office of city manager becomes vacant, the city
28	council shall appoint without delay a new manager or an acting

manager to fill the office until a new manager is designated.
