- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 95-3-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 95-3-29. (1) In any nuisance action, public or private,
- 8 against an agricultural operation, including forestry activity,
- 9 proof that said agricultural operation, including forestry
- 10 activity, has existed for one (1) year or more is an absolute
- 11 defense to such action, if the conditions or circumstances alleged
- 12 to constitute a nuisance have existed substantially unchanged
- 13 since the established date of operation.
- 14 (2) The following words and phrases as used in this section
- 15 shall have the meanings given them in this section:
- 16 (a) "Agricultural operation" includes, without
- 17 limitation, any facility for the production and processing of
- 18 crops, livestock, farm-raised fish and fish products, livestock
- 19 products, wood, timber or forest products, and poultry or poultry
- 20 products for commercial or industrial purposes. "Agricultural
- 21 operation" also includes the use of farm machinery, equipment,
- 22 devices, materials and structures designed for agricultural use
- 23 and the showing, testing and evaluating of animals, fowl or plants
- 24 for breeding or sales, or both, in accordance with traditional
- 25 farm practices.
- 26 (b) "Established date of operation" means the date on
- 27 which the agricultural operation, including forestry activity,

- 28 commenced operation. If the physical facilities of the
- 29 agricultural operation, including forestry activity, are
- 30 subsequently expanded, the established date of operation for each
- 31 expansion is deemed to be a separate and independent "established
- 32 date of operation" established as of the date of commencement of
- 33 the expanded operation and the commencement of expanded operation
- 34 shall not divest the agricultural operation of a previously
- 35 established date of operation.
- 36 (c) "Forestry activity" means any activity associated
- 37 with the reforesting, growing, managing, protecting and harvesting
- 38 of timber, wood and forest products including nongame species.
- 39 (d) "Traditional farm practices" means those accepted
- 40 customs and standards established and followed by similar
- 41 agricultural operations under similar circumstances.
- 42 (3) The provisions of this section shall not be construed to
- 43 affect any provision of the "Mississippi Air and Water Pollution
- 44 Control Law."
- 45 (4) This section shall not affect actions commenced prior to
- 46 July 1, 1980.
- 47 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 48 and after July 1, 2004.
