HOUSE BILL NO. 930

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NATIONAL COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (NCAA) MAY NOT CONTACT ANY INDIVIDUAL, STUDENT, SCHOOL OR COLLEGE REGARDING A NCAA INVESTIGATION UNLESS REGISTERED WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE; TO 3 4 REQUIRE THE REGISTERED REPRESENTATIVE TO IDENTIFY THE INDIVIDUAL 5 6 OR INSTITUTIONS TO BE CONTACTED DURING THE INVESTIGATION; TO 7 REQUIRE THE PAYMENT OF A REGISTRATION FEE AND ITS DEPOSIT INTO THE EMINENT SCHOLARS FUND; TO REQUIRE THE REGISTERED REPRESENTATIVE TO ADVISE A STUDENT OR INDIVIDUAL OF HIS OR HER RIGHT TO LEGAL 8 9 COUNSEL; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 10

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 12 **SECTION 1.** A representative of the National Collegiate
- 13 Athletic Association (NCAA) may not contact any resident of this
- 14 state, including a student attending, or any individual employed
- 15 by, a high school, community or junior college, or institution of
- 16 higher learning in this state, in connection with any specific
- 17 investigation being conducted by the NCAA in this state, before
- 18 being issued a certificate of registration under this act.
- 19 **SECTION 2.** (1) Each applicant for registration as a
- 20 representative of the NCAA shall submit an application for
- 21 registration to the Secretary of State in a form prescribed by the
- 22 Secretary of State.
- 23 (2) An application filed under this section is a public
- 24 record.
- 25 (3) The application must be in the name of an individual and
- 26 signed by the applicant and by the president of the NCAA, or his
- 27 designee, under penalty of perjury and must contain:
- 28 (a) The name of the applicant who will be participating
- 29 in a specific NCAA investigation in this state, and a telephone
- 30 number or address at which the applicant may be reached while in

- 31 this state, along with the name and address of his or her
- 32 immediate supervisor in the NCAA;
- 33 (b) A list of each student, individual, high school,
- 34 community or junior college, or institution of higher learning
- 35 that the applicant intends to contact in connection with the
- 36 investigation that is related to the application.
- 37 <u>SECTION 3.</u> An application for registration under this act
- 38 must be accompanied by a fee in the amount of One Thousand Five
- 39 Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), to be deposited by the Secretary of
- 40 State in the Eminent Scholars Fund established in Section
- 41 37-106-31, less the amount of twenty percent (20%) to defray the
- 42 administrative costs incurred by the Secretary of State.
- 43 **SECTION 4.** A registered representative of the NCAA may not
- 44 communicate with any student or other individual regarding the
- 45 subject investigation, unless he first advises the student or
- 46 individual of that student's or individual's right to legal
- 47 counsel.
- 48 **SECTION 5.** The violation of any provision of this act is a
- 49 misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, is punishable by a fine
- of not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisonment
- of not more than six (6) months, or both.
- 52 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 53 and after July 1, 2004.
