HOUSE BILL NO. 939

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE TOWN OF
2 CALEDONIA TO PURCHASE RADAR SPEED DETECTION EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY
3 LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY IN THE ENFORCEMENT OF
4 SPEED LIMITS ON THE ROADS AND STREETS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS
5 AND UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY; AND FOR RELATED
6 PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 **SECTION 1.** The governing authorities of the Town of
9 Caledonia, in their discretion, may expend out of any available
10 funds of the municipality, an amount that they determine is
11 sufficient for the purchase of radar speed detection equipment for
12 use by law enforcement officers of the municipality. If the
13 governing authorities authorize the expenditure of funds for this
14 purpose, then any duly sworn law enforcement of the municipality
15 may operate and use the equipment to enforce motor vehicle speed
16 limits on any public road or street within the corporate limits
17 and under the jurisdiction of the municipality.

18 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
19 and after July 1, 2004.
