## HOUSE BILL NO. 986

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-41, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 DELETE THE PROVISION THAT PROHIBITS A NONRESIDENT FROM KILLING 3 ANTLERLESS DEER EXCEPT UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; AND FOR 4 RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-41, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

8 49-7-41. (1) The commission may set the bag limits for game 9 animals, birds and fish, unless the bag limits are established by 10 the Legislature by statute.

(2) (a) The bag limit on antlered deer is one (1) per day, not to exceed three (3) per license year. An antlered deer must have antlers of four (4) points or greater to be taken except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection.

(b) An antlered deer with less than four (4) points may 15 16 be taken by permit if it is necessary to manage deer on lands 17 under the deer management assistance program or wildlife management areas. A written management justification issued by 18 the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks must accompany any 19 request for such a permit. Any antlered deer with less than four 20 21 (4) points harvested under this permit must be identified with a tag immediately upon possession. Antlered deer taken by permit 22 23 shall be subject to the daily bag limit but shall not be subject to the annual bag limit on antlered deer. The department shall 24 include a report on permits issued, to whom issued and deer 25 26 harvested in the department's annual deer program report. additional antlerless deer per license year may be taken with a bow and arrow. Antlerless deer may be taken only in the areas prescribed by order of the commission. It is illegal to take a spotted fawn in any season.

34 (4) The bag limit on antlerless deer set by this section
35 shall not apply to private lands under the deer management
36 assistance program or the fee-based antlerless program as approved
37 by the department.

38 (5) This section shall stand repealed on July 1, 2005.
 39 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
 40 and after July 1, 2004.
