## HOUSE BILL NO. 1136

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-3-53, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE OFFENSE OF KIDNAPPING; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** Section 97-3-53, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 5 amended as follows:
- 6 97-3-53. Any person who shall with or without intent to
- 7 secretly confine and without lawful authority forcibly seize and
- 8 confine any other person, or shall inveigle or kidnap any other
- 9 person with intent to cause such person to be \* \* \* confined or
- 10 imprisoned against his or her will, or shall without lawful
- 11 authority forcibly seize, inveigle or kidnap any child under the
- 12 age of sixteen (16) years \* \* \* against the will of the parents or
- 13 guardian or person having the lawful custody of such child, shall,
- 14 upon conviction, be imprisoned for life in the state penitentiary
- 15 if the punishment is so fixed by the jury in its verdict. If the
- 16 jury fails to agree on fixing the penalty at imprisonment for life
- 17 the court shall fix the penalty at not less than one (1) year nor
- 18 more than thirty (30) years in the state penitentiary.
- 19 This section shall not be held to repeal, modify or amend any
- 20 other criminal statute of this state.
- 21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after July 1, 2004.
