7	SECTION 1. Section 19-11-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
8	amended as follows:
9	[With regard to any county which is exempt from the
LO	provisions of Section 19-2-3, this section shall read as follows:]
L1	19-11-7. The board of supervisors of each county of the
L2	State of Mississippi shall, at its August meeting of each year,
L3	prepare a complete budget of revenues, expenses and a working cash
L4	balance estimated for the next fiscal year, which shall be based
L5	on the aggregate funds estimated to be available for the ensuing
L6	fiscal year for each fund, from which such estimated expenses will
L7	be paid, exclusive of school maintenance funds, which shall be
L8	shown separately. Such statement of revenues shall show every
L9	source of revenue along with the amount derived from each source.
20	The budget containing such statement of revenues and expenses
21	shall be published at least one (1) time during August or
22	September but not later than September 30 of the year in a
23	newspaper published in the county, or if no newspaper is published
24	therein, then in a newspaper having a general circulation therein.
25	The budget shall provide for funding of each of the various
26	offices and departments of county government at a level sufficient
27	to ensure that each of such offices and departments can provide at
