## HOUSE BILL NO. 1260

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 59-23-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REMOVE A REDUNDANT REFERENCE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE,
- 3 FISHERIES AND PARKS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 59-23-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 59-23-3. For the purposes of this chapter, the following
- 8 terms shall have the following meanings unless the context shall
- 9 prescribe otherwise:
- 10 (a) "Chemical test" means an analysis of a person's
- 11 blood, breath, urine or other bodily substance for the
- 12 determination of the presence of alcohol or any other substance
- 13 which may impair a person's mental or physical ability.

- 15 (b) "Intoxicated" means under the influence of alcohol
- 16 or any combination of alcohol, controlled substance or drugs, so
- 17 that there is impaired thought and action and loss of normal
- 18 control of a person's faculties to such an extent as to endanger
- 19 any person.
- 20 (c) "Law enforcement officer" means an officer
- 21 described in Section 63-11-19 \* \* \*.
- 22 (d) "Prima facie evidence of intoxication" includes
- 23 evidence that at the time of an alleged violation there was ten
- 24 one-hundredths percent (.10%) or more by weight of alcohol in the
- 25 person's blood.

- 26 (e) "Public waters" means all public waters over which
- 27 the state has jurisdiction.

28	(f) "Watercraft" means a motorized vessel with a motor
29	of twenty-five (25) horsepower or greater used for transportation
30	on public waters and personal watercraft (jet skis).
31	(g) "Operates a watercraft" or "operation of a
32	watercraft" shall mean a watercraft that is underway in the water
33	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
34	and after its passage.
