- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to
- 6 knowingly expose another person to a human immunodeficiency virus

- 8 (2) For a violation of this section where no cure is
