HOUSE BILL NO. 1298

- AN ACT TO PROHIBIT KNOWINGLY EXPOSING ANOTHER PERSON TO A SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED DISEASE; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to
- 6 knowingly expose another person to a sexually transmitted disease.
- 7 (2) For a violation of this section where no vaccine is
- 8 available for a sexually transmitted disease such violation shall
- 9 be a felony and, upon conviction, a violator shall be punished by
- 10 imprisonment for not more than ten (10) years and a fine of not
- 11 more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).
- 12 (3) For a violation of this section where a vaccine is
- 13 available for a sexually transmitted disease such violation shall
- 14 be a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, a violator shall be
- 15 punished by imprisonment for not more than one (1) year and a fine
- of not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).
- 17 (4) The provisions of this section shall be in addition to
- 18 any other provisions of law for which the actions described in
- 19 this section may be prosecuted.
- 20 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after July 1, 2004.
