## HOUSE BILL NO. 1298 (As Passed the House)

- AN ACT TO PROHIBIT KNOWINGLY EXPOSING ANOTHER PERSON TO A HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS (HIV); TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to
- 6 knowingly expose another person to a human immunodeficiency virus
- 7 (HIV). Prior knowledge and willing consent to the exposure is a
- 8 <u>defense to the crime set forth herein.</u>
- 9 (2) For a violation of this section where no cure is
- 10 available for such disease such violation shall be a felony and,
- 11 upon conviction, a violator shall be punished by imprisonment for
- 12 not more than ten (10) years and a fine of not more than Ten
- 13 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).
- 14 (3) The provisions of this section shall be in addition to
- 15 any other provisions of law for which the actions described in
- 16 this section may be prosecuted.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2004.
