With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 28 29 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 30 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 31 Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 32 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 33 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 34 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 35 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 36 37 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 38 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 39 40 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 41 42 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 43 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" 44 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 45 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 46 47 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 48 49 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law, except 50 51 that no transfers shall be authorized which increase the major 52 object of expenditure "Travel and Subsistence." No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 53 54 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 55 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 56 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 57

and after its passage.

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
