HOUSE BILL NO. 1354

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-56.74, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 2 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF THE FEE FOR THE 3 DISTINCTIVE "STOP CHILD ABUSE" MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAG SHALL BE 4 DEPOSITED IN THE MISSISSIPPI CHILDREN'S TRUST FUND; AND FOR 5 RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56.74, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

9 27-19-56.74. (1) Owners of motor vehicles upon complying with the motor vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing 10 of motor vehicles, and upon payment of the road and bridge 11 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 12 13 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 14 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional annual fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) 15 16 of this section, shall be entitled to a distinctive license tag that demonstrates their support for the prevention of child abuse. 17 The tags shall be of such color and design as the State Tax 18 19 Commission prescribes subject to the approval of the Mississippi License Tag Commission; however, each tag shall display the words 20 "Stop Child Abuse" and shall consist of such letters or numbers, 21 22 or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag.

(2) Application for the distinctive license tags shall be
made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State
Tax Commission. The application and the additional fee imposed
under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00)
thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to
the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the

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29 commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax 30 collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.

31 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 32 after July 1, 2003, any person applying for a distinctive license 33 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 34 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 35 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a 36 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 37 38 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 39 time the original application is made for a distinctive license tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 40 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 41 42 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax 43 collector. 44

45 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the 46 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, 47 the State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected 48 under this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute 49 such collections as follows:

50 (a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee
51 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
52 section shall be deposited into the <u>Mississippi Children's Trust</u>
53 <u>Fund</u> created in \* \* \* Section <u>93-21-305</u>.

(b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn
Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

(c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund

(d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section
27-19-44.2.

(5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as 67 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 68 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the 69 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 70 71 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, 72 73 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 74 tag.

In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license 75 (6) tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 76 77 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by 78 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 79 80 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 81 82 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 83 distinctive license tags issued under this section. 84

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86 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 87 and after July 1, 2004.
