HOUSE BILL NO. 1370

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 29-5-77, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 PROVIDE THAT DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION SHALL HAVE 2 JURISDICTION TO ENFORCE ALL STATE LAWS ON THE PROPERTIES OF THE 3 4 MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BUILDING AND THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM BUILDING; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 29-5-77, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8

29-5-77. The * * * Department of Finance and Administration 9 shall have jurisdiction relative to the enforcement of all laws of 10 the State of Mississippi on the properties set forth in Section 11 29-5-2, the Court of Appeals Building, the Mississippi Department 12 of Transportation Building and the Public Employees' Retirement 13 14 System Building. The Department of Finance and Administration shall, through any person or persons appointed by the Department 15 16 of Finance and Administration, or through the Department of Public Safety when requested by the Department of Finance and 17 Administration, make arrests for any violation of any law of the 18 19 State of Mississippi on those grounds of or within those properties. The Department of Finance and Administration shall 20 enforce the provisions of Sections 29-5-57 through 29-5-67, 21 22 29-5-71 through 29-5-77, and 29-5-81 through 29-5-95, and * * * prescribe such rules and regulations as are necessary therefor. 23 When in the opinion of the Governor or, in his absence, the 24 Lieutenant Governor, it is readily apparent that an emergency 25 exists that the persons appointed by the Department of Finance and 26 27 Administration are unable to control in the accomplishment of the 28 provisions of Sections 29-5-57 through 29-5-67, 29-5-71 through

29 29-5-77, and 29-5-81 through 29-5-95 in regard to law enforcement, 30 then the Governor, or in his absence, the Lieutenant Governor, may 31 call upon the Department of Public Safety, members of which shall 32 have power to arrest and detain any persons violating the 33 provisions of <u>those</u> sections <u>of law</u>, until <u>the</u> person can be 34 brought before the proper authorities for trial.

35 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after July 1, 2004.
