HOUSE BILL NO. 1407 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A COMMITTEE TO MAKE A RECOMMENDATION TO 2 THE LEGISLATURE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MISSISSIPPI 3 CLEARINGHOUSE FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 6 SECTION 1. A committee is hereby established to make a 7 report to the Legislature on the establishment of a Clearinghouse for People with Disabilities to promote and facilitate the full 8 9 participation of, and the creation and assurance of equal 10 opportunities for all people with disabilities. "People with disabilities" means individuals who have physical, sensory, 11 cognitive or mental characteristics such as those listed under the 12 definition of "handicapped person" in Regulation 28CFR 4.31(b) for 13 the implementation of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 14 1973, as amended (Public Law 93-112). The membership of the 15 16 committee shall be as follows: (a) the State Superintendent of 17 Education, or his designee; (b) the Executive Director of the State Department of Health, or his designee; (c) the Executive 18 19 Director of the Mississippi Department of Human Services, or his designee; (d) the Executive Director of the Division of Medicaid, 20 21 Office of Governor, or his designee; (e) the Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Mental Health, or his designee; (f) 22 23 the Executive Director of the State Department of Rehabilitation Services, or his designee; (g) the Chairmen of the Appropriations 24 and Public Health and Welfare Committees of each house of the 25 26 Legislature, or their designees; (h) a representative of the Coalition for Citizens with Disabilities appointed by the 27 28 Governor; (i) a representative of an advocacy group for the *HR03/R1846SG* H. disabled appointed by the Lieutenant Governor; and (j) a 29 30 representative of an advocacy group for the disabled appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The committee shall 31 32 meet upon call of the Governor not later than August 1, 2004, and 33 shall select a chairman who shall organize the committee for business. Staff and clerical support for the committee shall be 34 provided by the agencies represented on the committee. 35 The committee shall develop a request with specific recommendations 36 for legislation and shall make its report to the Chairmen of the 37 Committees of Public Health and Welfare of each house on or before 38 39 December 1, 2004.

40 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 41 and after July 1, 2004.
