AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 2 AND 4, CHAPTER 82, LAWS OF 2003, 1 TO TRANSFER FUNDS IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2004 APPROPRIATION TO THE 2 STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FROM ONE CATEGORY TO ANOTHER; TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD TO USE CERTAIN FUNDS TO PURCHASE FURNITURE, FIXTURES, 3 4 EQUIPMENT AND A VEHICLE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 2, Chapter 82, Laws of 2003, is amended 8 as follows: Section 2. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 29 30 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 31 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 32 Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 33 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 34 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 35 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 36 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 37 38 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 39 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 40 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal 41 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 42 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 43 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 44 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" 45 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 46 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 47 48 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 49

50 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 51 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

52 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 53 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 54 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 55 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

56 SECTION 2. Section 4, Chapter 82, Laws of 2003, is amended 57 as follows:

Section 4. In addition to all other funds heretofore appropriated, the following sum is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Pharmacy for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the H. B. No. 1466 *HR03/R1592* 04/HR03/R1592
