HOUSE BILL NO. 1490

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-573, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO CLARIFY WHAT INFORMATION IS REQUIRED ON AN AFFIDAVIT BALLOT; 2. 3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. Section 23-15-573, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 23-15-573. Any person whose name does not appear upon the 7 8 pollbooks shall be permitted to vote in an election; but if any person offering to vote in any election whose name does not appear 9 upon the pollbook shall make affidavit before one (1) of the 10 managers of election in writing that he is entitled to vote, or 11 that he has been illegally denied registration, his vote may be 12 13 prepared by him and handed to the proper election officer who shall enclose the same in an envelope with the written affidavit 14 15 of the voter, seal the envelope and mark plainly upon it the name of the person offering to vote. The affidavit must include (a) 16 the complete name, which may be the signature of the affiant or 17 the printed name of the affiant, (b) any previous or former 18 addresses, if applicable, (c) present address, (d) a home or work 19 20 telephone number, (e) the signature of the affiant, and (f) the 21 signature of one (1) of the election managers. A separate register 22 shall be maintained for affidavit ballots, and the affiant shall sign the register upon completing an affidavit under this section. 23 In canvassing the returns of the election, the executive committee 24 in primary elections, or the election commissioners, in a general 25 26 election, shall examine the records and allow the ballot to be counted, or not counted, as it appears to be legal.
