HOUSE BILL NO. 1567

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-67, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO  
2 PROVIDE THAT GOVERNING AUTHORITIES MAY DEDUCT FROM A MUNICIPAL  
3 EMPLOYEE'S SALARY AN AMOUNT TO BE DEPOSITED WITH CERTAIN  
4 ORGANIZATIONS AT THE REQUEST OF THE EMPLOYEE; TO CLARIFY THAT  
5 STATE AGENCIES MAY DEDUCT FROM A STATE EMPLOYEE'S SALARY AN AMOUNT  
6 TO BE DEPOSITED WITH ANY ORGANIZATION AT THE REQUEST OF THE  
7 EMPLOYEE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

9 **SECTION 1.** Section 25-3-67, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
10 amended as follows:

11 25-3-67. (1) The governing authorities of any municipality  
12 or the board of supervisors of any county, within their  
13 discretion, may deduct from the salary of any individual municipal  
14 employee an amount to be deposited with the municipal credit  
15 union, contributions for the American Cancer Society, United Way,  
16 life, health-and-accident insurance and United States Savings  
17 Bonds, if a request for such deductions is made in writing by the  
18 employee.

19 (2) Any state agency, within the discretion of the executive  
20 head of the state agency, may deduct from the salary of a state  
21 employee an amount to be deposited with the American Cancer  
22 Society or any other organization, group or company, if a request  
23 for any such deductions is made in writing by the employee.

24 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
25 and after July 1, 2004.
