HOUSE BILL NO. 1710

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI STATE PORT AUTHORITY AT GULFPORT 2 3 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2005. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out 6 of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available 7 8 to the Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the authority for the fiscal 9 year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... 10 \$ 37,705,909.00. 11 SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions 12 13 of Section 1, the following positions are authorized: AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 14 15 Permanent: Full Time.... 68 16 Part Time..... 0 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 17 0 18 Part Time..... Ω Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 19 20 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law. 21 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 22 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 23 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 24 SECTION 3. The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund 25 26 all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions:

27 (1) The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant28 positions;

29 (2) The agency shall not take any action to promote or30 otherwise award salary increases through reallocation,

31 reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, 32 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions 33 except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No. 34 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

35 (3) The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state
36 travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
37 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

38 (4) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or
39 contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for
40 support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the
41 Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology
42 Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
43 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

44 (5) The agency shall not expend funds to publish or45 distribute any annual reports or other publications;

46 (6) The agency shall not expend funds for public relation
47 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the
48 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
49 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

50 (7) The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs 51 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development 52 Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry 53 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;

54 (8) The agency shall not expend funds for staff development55 or training services;

(9) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of
new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease
purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this

61 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 62 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 63 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate 64 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 65 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 66 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 67 68 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 69 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following 70 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 71 Mississippi State Legislature."

72 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport shall maintain 73 74 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 75 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 76 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of 77 78 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 79 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 80 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request 81 82 process.

83 SECTION 6. In the event of a natural disaster or other major catastrophe whereby the expenditure of funds above the limits 84 85 contained herein are deemed necessary to rapidly repair or restore 86 port facilities, the Port Authority and the Mississippi Development Authority, with the approval of the Department of 87 Finance and Administration, may escalate expenditures under 88 89 Section 1 and the major objects contained in Section 2. However, 90 no escalation shall be authorized until source and availability of 91 such funds is shown.

No. 1710 *HR05/A936* 04/HR05/A936 PAGE 3 (RM\ST) 92 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 93 Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport is hereby authorized 94 to escalate and expend funds from any source in accordance with 95 applicable rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and 96 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 97 federal funds.

98 **SECTION 8.** The money appropriated under the provisions of 99 Section 1 shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper 100 person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

101 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 102 and after July 1, 2004.
