## HOUSE BILL NO. 1715

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 1 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 2 3 STATE BOARD OF OPTOMETRY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2005. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 6 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Board of 7 8 Optometry, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending 9 June 30, 2005..... \$ 76,820.00. 10 SECTION 2. The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund 11 12 all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions: 13 (1) The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant 14 positions; 15 (2) The agency shall not take any action to promote or 16 otherwise award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, 17 18 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No. 19 20 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session; 21 (3) The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state 22 travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session; 23 (4) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or 24 contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for 25 26 support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the 27 Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology

30 (5) The agency shall not expend funds to publish or31 distribute any annual reports or other publications;

32 (6) The agency shall not expend funds for public relation
33 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the
34 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
35 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

36 (7) The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs 37 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development 38 Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry 39 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;

40 (8) The agency shall not expend funds for staff development41 or training services;

42 (9) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of 43 new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease 44 purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this 45 appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set 46 forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session.

47 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 48 49 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate 50 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 51 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 52 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 53 54 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 55 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 56 Mississippi State Legislature." 57

58 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 59 State Board of Optometry shall maintain complete accounting and 60 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds H. B. No. 1715 \*HR05/A831\* 04/HR05/A831

04/HR05/A831 PAGE 2 (RM\ST) appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 68 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 69 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 70 71 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 72 73 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 74 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2004. 75
