1 2 3 4 5	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM BUILDING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2005.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
9	Treasury to the credit of the Administrative Expense Account of
10	the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of
11	defraying the administrative expenses of the Board of Trustees of
12	the Public Employees' Retirement System, or out of any money in
13	the State Treasury to the credit of the Retirement System Building
14	Account of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose
15	of maintenance and general operation of the Retirement System
16	Building, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending
17	June 30, 2005\$ 9,133,124.00.
18	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
19	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
20	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
21	expenditure:

38	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
39	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
40	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
41	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
42	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
43	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
44	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
45	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
46	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
47	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
48	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
49	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
50	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
51	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
52	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
53	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
54	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
55	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services"
56	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
57	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
58	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
59	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
60	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

- 63 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 64 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The

- 66 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be

- 79 reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder,
- 80 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions
- 81 except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No.
- 82 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;
- 83 (3) The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state
- 84 travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 85 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;
- 86 (4) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or
- 87 contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for
- 88 support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the
- 89 Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology
- 90 Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 91 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;
- 92 (5) The agency shall not expend funds to publish or
- 93 distribute any annual reports or other publications;

- 94 (6) The agency shall not expend funds for public relation 95 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the 96 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 97 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;
- 98 (7) The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs 99 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development 100 Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry
- 101 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;
- 102 (8) The agency shall not expend funds for staff development 103 or training services;
- 104 (9) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of
  105 new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease
  106 purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this
  107 appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set
  108 forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session.

    SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following language: "Funds were made available for this project by the Mississippi State Legislature."
- Board of Trustees of the Public Employees' Retirement System shall
  maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the
  expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
  records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
  maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of
  the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year

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     2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
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     in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
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     of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request

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          SECTION 6.
                      The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
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     necessary, while remaining within the project cost of Sixteen
     Million Four Hundred Thirty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-five
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     Dollars ($16,432,885.00) is hereby reappropriated out of any money
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     in the State Treasury to the credit of the Building Fund Expense
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     Account of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose
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     of construction and renovation to the existing building and
     parking facilities located at 429 Mississippi Street in Jackson,
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     Mississippi, including architectural fees and furnishings, as well
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     as associated moving expenses and to provide monies for the lease
     of facilities while the construction/renovation is underway, for
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     the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
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     .....$3,000,000.00.
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          The expenditure of funds appropriated under this section
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     shall be subject to the approval of the Department of Finance and
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     Administration, and the Department of Finance and Administration
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     shall submit an annual report regarding such expenditures to the
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     Legislative Budget Office, the House Public Buildings, Grounds and
     Lands Committee and the Senate Public Property Committee.
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          SECTION 7.
                      In accordance with the purposes of this article,
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     there shall be established in the State Treasury the Public
     Employees' Retirement System Building Repair and Maintenance Fund,
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     into which shall be deposited all funds collected as rental income
     from the building owned by the system located at 301 North
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     President Street, Jackson, Mississippi. At the end of each fiscal
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     year, any and all unexpended funds shall be transferred to the
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     Administrative Budget Fund of the system.
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          It is the intention of the Legislature that the system have
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the authority to escalate the Public Employees' Retirement System

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160	Building Repair and Maintenance Fund in an amount not to exceed
161	Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for repair and
162	maintenance of the buildings owned by the system. All
163	expenditures from the Public Employees' Retirement System Building
164	Repair and Maintenance Fund shall be in accordance with this
165	article and for the purposes designated herein.
166	SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
167	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
168	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
169	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
170	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
171	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
172	SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from

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and after July 1, 2004.
