HOUSE BILL NO. 1725 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 1 2 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 3 MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2005. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of Transportation Funds, 8 9 for the purpose of defraying the administrative expenses of the Mississippi Department of Transportation for the fiscal year 10 beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... 11\$ 857,837,415.00. 12 SECTION 2. The following offices are supported by the funds 13 appropriated in Section 1: The Office of Administrative Services, 14 the Office of Highways, the Office of Aeronautics and Rails and 15 the Office of Enforcement. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 36 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 37 38 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 39 Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 40 41 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the 42 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 43 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 44 45 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 46 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 47 48 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 49 50 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 51 52 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 53 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 54 55 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 56 57 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written

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62 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 63 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 64 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 65 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 66 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated to the Mississippi Department of Transportation under the provisions of Section 1 and authorized for expenditure in Section 2, the following amounts shall be available for expenditure in the program budgets as required by Section 27-103-127, Mississippi Code of 1972:

The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund 82

all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions:(1) The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant

85 positions;

86 (2) The agency shall not take any action to promote or87 otherwise award salary increases through reallocation,

88 reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, 89 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions 90 except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No. 91 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

92 (3) The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state
93 travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
94 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

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101 (5) The agency shall not expend funds to publish or102 distribute any annual reports or other publications;

103 (6) The agency shall not expend funds for public relation 104 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the 105 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House 106 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

107 (7) The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs 108 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development 109 Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry 110 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority; 111 (8) The agency shall not expend funds for staff development

112 or training services;

(9) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session.

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 118 119 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate 120 121 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 122 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening 123 124 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 125 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 126 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following

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127 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 128 Mississippi State Legislature."

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 129 130 Mississippi Department of Transportation shall maintain complete 131 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 132 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 133 Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 134 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be 135 136 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 137 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 138

139 SECTION 7. In accordance with Section 39 of House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session, the Mississippi Department 140 141 of Transportation shall transfer all employees, equipment, inventory and resources of the department employed and used as law 142 143 enforcement personnel to the Department of Public Safety on July 144 The transfer of personnel shall be commensurate with the 1, 2004. number and classification of positions allocated to that law 145 146 enforcement. The transfer also shall include direct support, 147 clerical, data processing and communications positions allocated 148 to that enforcement.

SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and authorized for expenditure in Section 2, it is the intention of the Legislature that Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be transferred to the Department of Agriculture and Commerce for the Beaver Control or Eradication Program during the Fiscal Year 2005.

SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act, the Mississippi Department of Transportation shall expend such funds as necessary to conduct project planning. Such project planning shall apply to all preliminary engineering, right-of-way acquisition and construction projects of the department and, at a H. B. No. 1725 *HR40/A941PH*

(a) Establish a reasonable cost estimate for each
project. For purposes of this provision, projects include
preliminary engineering, right-of-way acquisition and
construction;

(b) Capture and retain the initial project cost
estimates for comparison with final actual expenditures;
(c) Require that any changes to a cost estimate for a
project will be reviewed and approved by district or central
office personnel. Such personnel shall be responsible for signing

171 any revision, and providing a narrative description of the reasons 172 for approving a revision;

(d) Capture the cost of consultants, engineers,
attorneys, contract appraisers and other technical and
professional contractors used in preliminary engineering,
right-of-way acquisition and construction projects.

177 **SECTION 10.** (1) None of the funds appropriated under the 178 provisions of Section 1 of this act may be expended by the 179 Department of Transportation for construction of new highways if 180 such highway segment is less than ten (10) miles in length unless:

(a) The explanation and justification for letting such
a contract for a length of less than ten (10) miles is entered
upon the official minutes of the Transportation Commission;

(b) The commission, within ten (10) working days after entry of its explanation and justification upon its minutes, gives notice, by United States First Class Mail, and provides a copy of such entry upon its minutes, to the Chairman of the Transportation Committee of the Mississippi House of Representatives and the Chairman of the Mississippi Senate Highways and Transportation Committee.

191 SECTION 11. Of the funds appropriated to the Mississippi 192 Department of Transportation, Three Hundred Thousand Dollars H. B. No. 1725 *HR40/A941PH* 04/HR40/A941PH

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193 (\$300,000.00) shall be used for the Statewide Litter Prevention
194 Program.

SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Department of Transportation is hereby authorized to receive, budget and expend in the Capital Outlay major object of expenditure an amount not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) resulting from funds received from third party damages.

SECTION 13. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and allocated in Section 2, not less than Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00) shall be expended for contracted maintenance overlay and pavement rehabilitation.

205 SECTION 14. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 206 Mississippi Department of Transportation shall have the authority 207 to escalate its budget in the Capital Outlay - Other Than 208 Equipment or the Commodities major objects of expenditure in the 209 Maintenance Program, with funds which were obligated in Fiscal 210 Year 2004 for maintenance overlay projects and maintenance repair projects but not completed by the end of Fiscal Year 2004, in an 211 212 amount not to exceed Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00). Anv escalation made from the authority granted in this Section shall 213 214 be reported to the Chairmen of the Appropriations Committees of the Mississippi Senate and the Mississippi House of 215 216 Representatives, the Chairman of the Highways and Transportation 217 Committee of the Mississippi Senate, the Chairman of the Transportation Committee of the Mississippi House of 218 219 Representatives, and the Legislative Budget Office, within fifteen (15) working days after said escalation. 220

SECTION 15. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

227 <u>SECTION 16.</u> It is the intent of the Legislature that no 228 state money will be used in additional brick work and cosmetic 229 design on bridge or road projects.

230 SECTION <u>17.</u> This act shall take effect and be in force from 231 and after July 1, 2004.
