AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE -1 DIVISION OF MEDICAID FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING MEDICAL 2 3 ASSISTANCE UNDER THE MISSISSIPPI MEDICAID LAW AND DEFRAYING THE 4 EXPENSES OF THE ADMINISTRATION OF SUCH LAW FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 5 2005 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 8 9 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Governor's Office - Division of Medicaid for the purpose of providing medical 10 assistance under the Mississippi Medicaid Law and defraying the 11 expenses of the administration of such law, as provided in Section 12 43-13-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year 13 14 beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... 15\$ 247,025,158.00. 16 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 17 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Medical Care Fund created by Section 18 19 43-13-143, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of providing medical assistance under the Mississippi Medicaid Law for the 20 21 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... 22\$ 180,014,150.00. 23 SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 24 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Governor's Office 25 - Division of Medicaid which is comprised of special source funds 26 27 collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for the purpose of providing medical assistance under the Mississippi 28

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Medicaid Law and defraying the expenses of the administration of 29 30 such law, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... \$ 2,879,011,007.00. 31 32 Prior period recovery of funds may be maintained and expended 33 by the division when the recovery is received or finalized. 34 SECTION 4. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 35 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Health Care Expendable Fund, for the 36 purpose of defraying the expenses of the Governor's Office -37 Division of Medicaid for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, 38 39 and ending June 30, 2005..... \$ 75,057,956.00. SECTION 5. 79	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
80	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
81	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
82	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
83	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
84	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
85	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
86	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
87	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
88	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
89	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
90	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
91	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
92	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
93	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
94	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this

No. 1734 04/HR05/A328 PAGE 3 (\st) 95 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 96 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 97 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 98 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 99 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

100 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 101 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 102 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 103 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 104 The 105 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 106 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 107 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level. 108

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

113 **SECTION 6.** The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund 114 all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions:

115 (1) The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant 116 positions;

117 (2) The agency shall not take any action to promote or118 otherwise award salary increases through reallocation,

119 reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, 120 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions 121 except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No. 122 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

123 (3) The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state
124 travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
125 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

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128 support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the 129 Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology 130 Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House 131 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

132 (5) The agency shall not expend funds to publish or133 distribute any annual reports or other publications;

134 (6) The agency shall not expend funds for public relation
135 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the
136 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
137 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

138 (7) The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs 139 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development 140 Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry 141 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;

142 (8) The agency shall not expend funds for staff development143 or training services;

144 (9) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of 145 new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease 146 purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this 147 appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set 148 forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session.

149 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 150 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 151 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate 152 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 153 154 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening 155 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 156 157 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following 158 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 159 Mississippi State Legislature."

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SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 160 161 Governor's Office - Division of Medicaid shall maintain complete 162 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 163 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 164 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 165 Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be 166 167 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 168 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 169 170 SECTION 9. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 171 172 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 173 174 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted 175 176 performance measures provided below: 177 FY2005 178 Performance Measures Target 179 Administrative Services 180 Admin as a Percent of Total Budget (%) 2.80 181 Medical Services 182 Recipients (Persons) 725,000 183 Recipients in Managed Care (Persons) 0 184 Primary Care Physicians (Persons) 8,400 A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets 185 186 set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget 187 188 Committee for Fiscal Year 2006. 189 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive Director of the Division of Medicaid may authorize 190 191 increases in any major objects of expenditures in total amounts 192 not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount *HR05/A328* H. 193 of each major object of expenditure, provided that other major 194 objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar 195 amount.

SECTION 11. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 3, Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00) shall be derived from the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972.

200 SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 201 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 202 203 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 204 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 205 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 206 SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from 207 and after July 1, 2004.
