HOUSE BILL NO. 1737

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 1 2 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 3 STATE BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR FORESTERS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 4 2005. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Registered Foresters 8 9 Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Board of Registration for Foresters for the fiscal year beginning 10 July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... \$ 11 29,800.00. SECTION 2. The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund 12 all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions: 13 (1) The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant 14 positions; 15 16 (2) The agency shall not take any action to promote or 17 otherwise award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, 18 19 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No. 20 21 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session; (3) The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state 22 23 travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House 24 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session; (4) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or 25 26 contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the 27 Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology 28 *HR05/A844* H. B. No. 1737 A1/2 04/HR05/A844

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29 Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House 30 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

31 (5) The agency shall not expend funds to publish or
32 distribute any annual reports or other publications;

33 (6) The agency shall not expend funds for public relation
34 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the
35 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
36 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

37 (7) The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs
38 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development
39 Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry
40 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;

41 (8) The agency shall not expend funds for staff development
42 or training services;

(9) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of
new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease
purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this
appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set
forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session.

48 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 49 50 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 51 52 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 53 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 54 55 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 56 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following 57 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the Mississippi State Legislature." 58

59 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 60 State Board of Registration for Foresters shall maintain complete 61 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all H. B. No. 1737 *HRO5/A844* 04/HR05/A844 PAGE 2 (RM\ST) funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 69 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 70 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 71 72 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 73 74 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 75 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2004. 76
