- 205 budget and expend funds, not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand
- 206 Dollars (\$500,000.00), from special funds in the State Treasury to
- 207 the credit of the New Capitol Repair and Renovation Fund created
- 208 in Section 27-19-56.69 (8), Mississippi Code of 1972, for the
- 209 purpose of paying the costs of repair and renovation of the New
- 210 Capitol, in accordance with rules and regulations of the
- 211 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent
- 212 with the escalation of federal funds.
- 213 **SECTION 13.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of
- 214 this act, One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00)is
- 215 provided for the purpose of developing, maintaining and operating
- 216 Beauvoir Shrine, the last home of Jefferson Davis, the only
- 217 President of the Confederate States of America.
- 218 **SECTION 14.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 219 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 220 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 221 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 222 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 223 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

224 **SECTION 15.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 225 and after July 1, 2004.
