HOUSE BILL NO. 1744

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER 1 PARKWAY COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF 2 THE COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2005. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi River 7 8 Parkway Commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and 9 ending June 30, 2005..... \$ 10 25,488.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 13 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi River Parkway Commission which is comprised of special source funds collected by or 14 15 otherwise available to the commission, for the purpose of 16 defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... 17 18\$ 13,762.00. 19 SECTION 3. The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund 20 all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions: 21 (1) The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant 22 positions; (2) The agency shall not take any action to promote or 23 otherwise award salary increases through reallocation, 24 reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, 25 26 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions

27 except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No.
28 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

(3) The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state
travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

32 (4) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or
33 contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for
34 support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the
35 Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology
36 Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
37 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

38 (5) The agency shall not expend funds to publish or39 distribute any annual reports or other publications;

40 (6) The agency shall not expend funds for public relation
41 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the
42 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
43 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;

44 (7) The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs
45 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development
46 Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry
47 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;

48 (8) The agency shall not expend funds for staff development49 or training services;

50 (9) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of 51 new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease 52 purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this 53 appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set 54 forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session.

55 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 56 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 57 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate 58 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 59 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public H. 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60 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening 61 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 62 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 63 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following 64 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 65 Mississippi State Legislature."

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 66 Mississippi River Parkway Commission shall maintain complete 67 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 68 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 69 70 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 71 72 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 73 74 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 75

76 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 77 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 78 79 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 80 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 81 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 82 and after July 1, 2004. 83
