165 Part Time..... 0 166 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 167 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 168 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 169 170 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the 171 172 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 173 174 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 175 176 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 177 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal 178 179 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 180 181 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 182 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 183 184 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 185 186 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 187 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The H. B. No. 1748 *HRO5/A330* 04/HR05/A330 PAGE 6 (\ST) 193 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 194 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 195 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 196 appropriated level.

197 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 198 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 199 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 200 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

201 It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive Director of the Department of Rehabilitation Services may transfer 202 203 between the various offices authorized herein both funds and positions not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the receiving 204 205 office in addition to any other transfers or escalations made in 206 accordance with Section 27-104-17 (3), Mississippi Code of 1972, 207 Annotated. The Executive Director of the Department of 208 Rehabilitation Services shall submit written justification for the 209 transfer to the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of 210 Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth of the month prior to the effective date of the transfer. It is further the 211 212 intention of the Legislature that any transfers made under the 213 provisions of this paragraph shall be of an emergency nature and that in no case shall the transfers be made which substantially 214 alter the legislative intent for the various offices as set forth 215 216 in the original appropriations made under this act.

217 SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein 218 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 219 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds which are 220 received by or otherwise become available to the Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation Services to provide funding for 221 construction grants and establishment grants for the fiscal year 222 beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... 223 224\$ 4,000,000.00.

(1) The agency shall not fill any current or future vacantpositions;

(2) The agency shall not take any action to promote or

or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions

(7) The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs
or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development
Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry
out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;

(8) The agency shall not expend funds for staff developmentor training services;

256 (9) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of 257 new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease

261 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 262 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 263 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 264 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 265 266 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening 267 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 268 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following 269 270 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 271 Mississippi State Legislature."

SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 272 Department of Rehabilitation Services shall maintain complete 273 274 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 275 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 276 277 Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be 278 279 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 280 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 281

SECTION 9. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.

It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972. H. B. No. 1748 *HRO5/A330* 04/HR05/A330

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SECTION 10. Of the funds in Sections 1, 2 and 3, the Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation Services through the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation for the Blind is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for the National Federation for the Blind (NFB) Newsline service to allow blind and visually impaired persons to access newspapers through toll-free telephone calls.

298 SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 299 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 300 301 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 302 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 303 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 304 SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from 305 and after July 1, 2004.
