1 2	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF REHABILITATION SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of
7	Rehabilitation Services for the fiscal year beginning
8	July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005 \$ 6,791,723.00.
9	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
10	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special
11	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of
12	Rehabilitation Services which is comprised of special source funds
13	collected by or otherwise available to the department for the
14	support of the various offices of the department, for the purpose
15	of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year
16	beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
17	\$ 112,486,714.00.
18	SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
19	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
20	Treasury to the credit of the Health Care Expendable Fund, for the
21	purpose of defraying the expenses of the Department of
22	Rehabilitation Services for the fiscal year beginning
23	July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005 \$ 6,461,421.00.

166	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
167	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
168	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
169	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
170	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
171	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
172	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
173	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
174	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
175	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
176	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
177	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
178	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
179	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
180	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
181	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
182	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
183	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services"
184	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
185	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
186	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
187	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
188	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
189	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
190	allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
191	Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
192	approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
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193	Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
194	approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
195	without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
196	appropriated level.
197	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
198	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
199	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
200	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
201	It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive
202	Director of the Department of Rehabilitation Services may transfer
203	between the various offices authorized herein both funds and
204	positions not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the receiving
205	office in addition to any other transfers or escalations made in
206	accordance with Section 27-104-17 (3), Mississippi Code of 1972,
207	Annotated. The Executive Director of the Department of
208	Rehabilitation Services shall submit written justification for the
209	transfer to the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of
210	Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth of the month
211	prior to the effective date of the transfer. It is further the
212	intention of the Legislature that any transfers made under the
213	provisions of this paragraph shall be of an emergency nature and
214	that in no case shall the transfers be made which substantially
215	alter the legislative intent for the various offices as set forth
216	in the original appropriations made under this act.
217	SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein
218	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
219	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds which are
220	received by or otherwise become available to the Mississippi
221	Department of Rehabilitation Services to provide funding for
222	construction grants and establishment grants for the fiscal year
223	beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
224	\$ 4,000,000.00.

225	SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
226	Department of Rehabilitation Services shall maintain complete
227	accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
228	funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
229	in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
230	Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
231	the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be
232	submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
233	and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
234	provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.
235	SECTION 7. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or
236	other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of
237	any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of
238	Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for
239	any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of
240	Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.
241	It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles
242	authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply
243	with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972.
244	SECTION 8. Of the funds in Sections 1, 2 and 3, the
245	Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation Services through the
246	Office of Vocational Rehabilitation for the Blind is authorized to
247	expend an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars
248	(\$100,000.00) for the National Federation for the Blind (NFB)
249	Newsline service to allow blind and visually impaired persons to
250	access newspapers through toll-free telephone calls.
251	SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
252	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
253	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
254	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
255	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
256	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

257 **SECTION 10.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 258 and after July 1, 2004.
