HOUSE BILL NO. 1749

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO MARIETTA JOHNSON  
2 OF OKTIBBEHA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Marietta Johnson of Oktibbeha County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her  
7 conviction of robbery in Oktibbeha County, Mississippi, in 2000,  
8 and who has completed the penalty and any conditions imposed upon  
9 her for such conviction. The Legislature has been reliably  
10 informed that she is now conducting herself as a law-abiding and  
11 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
13 and after its passage.
