HOUSE BILL NO. 1818

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JOHN PAUL LUMPKIN  
2 OF PEARL RIVER COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to John Paul Lumpkin of Pearl River County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of  
7 his conviction of burglary/general in Pearl River County,  
8 Mississippi, in 1993, and who has completed the penalty and any  
9 conditions imposed upon him for such conviction. The Legislature  
10 has been reliably informed that he is now conducting himself as a  
11 law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
13 and after its passage.
