## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 20

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE GLOBAL SULLIVAN 1 2 PRINCIPLES OF CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY AND ENCOURAGING 3 COMPANIES, LARGE AND SMALL, DOMESTIC AND INTERNATIONAL, TO ADOPT 4 THESE PRINCIPLES. 5 WHEREAS, the late Reverend Leon H. Sullivan, Founder and former Chairman of the Opportunities Industrialization Centers of 6 America, initiated the Sullivan Principles in 1977; and 7 WHEREAS, the Sullivan Principles have been recognized as one 8 9 of the most effective efforts to end discrimination in the 10 workforce of South Africa; and WHEREAS, on November 2, 1999, at the United Nations, Reverend 11 Sullivan, under the auspices of Secretary General Kofi Annan, 12 introduced the Global Sullivan Principles of Corporate Social 13 14 Responsibility; and WHEREAS, the Global Sullivan Principles of Corporate Social 15 16 Responsibility encourages companies, large and small, domestic and international, to respect the law and apply the principles with 17 integrity and consistent with the legitimate role of business; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Mississippi commends Reverend Sullivan posthumously for his contribution to protecting 20 21 and strengthening human rights and dignity in the United States and around the world, and unanimously approves in concept the 22 23 Global Sullivan Principles of Corporate Social Responsibility as 24 follows: Express our support for universal human rights and, 25

26 particularly, those of our employees, the communities within which 27 we operate, and parties with whom we do business;

Respect our employees' voluntary freedom of association; Compensate our employees to enable them to meet at least their basic needs and provide them the opportunity to improve their skill and capability in order to raise their social economic opportunities;

Provide a safe and healthy workplace; protect human rights, 39 40 health and the environment; and promote sustainable development; Promote fair competition including respect for intellectual 41 and other property rights, and not offer, pay or accept bribes; 42 Work with governments and communities in which we do business 43 44 to improve the quality of life in training and opportunities for workers from disadvantaged backgrounds; 45 Promote the application of these principles by those with 46

47 whom we do business; and

WHEREAS, the application of these principles will help lead to greater tolerance and understanding and advance the culture of peace:

51 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF 52 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING 53 THEREIN, That we do hereby endorse the Global Sullivan Principles 54 of Corporate Social Responsibility.
