HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 28

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE LIFE AND MEMORY OF
2 CHARLES EDWARD TAYLOR AND RECOGNIZING MAY 24 AS AVIATION
3 MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN DAY IN HIS HONOR.

4 WHEREAS, Charles Edward Taylor was born on May 24, 1869; and

5 WHEREAS, in 1902, Charles Edward Taylor began working as a
6 machinist for Orville and Wilbur Wright at the Wright Cycle
7 Company in Dayton, Ohio; and

8 WHEREAS, within six weeks, Charles Edward Taylor, using only
9 a lathe and drill press, built the first engine used to power the
10 Wright Flyer; and

11 WHEREAS, his ingenuity earned him a place in aviation history
12 when the Wright Brothers successfully flew their airplane on
13 December 17, 1903; and

14 WHEREAS, after this historic event, Charles Edward Taylor
15 continued to design engines for the Wright Brothers and later
16 taught them to build aircraft engines; and

17 WHEREAS, in 1908, Mr. Taylor accompanied Orville Wright to
18 Fort Meyer, Virginia, for test flights by the United States
19 government and in 1909, accompanied Wilbur Wright to New York for
20 the Hudson-Fulton flights; and

21 WHEREAS, Charles Edward Taylor served as lead mechanic for
22 Calbraith (Cal) Rodgers, who made his first transcontinental
23 flight in 1911; and

24 WHEREAS, Mr. Taylor had a successful career in aviation
25 maintenance for more than sixty years; and

26 WHEREAS, Charles Edward Taylor was honored by the Federal
27 Aviation Administration with the establishment of the Charles

28 Edward Taylor Master Mechanic Award, which recognizes persons with
29 fifty years or more of aviation maintenance experience; and

30 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
31 and commend excellence as exhibited by the life, accomplishments
32 and memory of Mr. Charles Edward Taylor, whose achievements in
33 aviation maintenance set the mark for the future of aviation:

34 NOW, THEREFORE, ON BEHALF OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
35 THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, That we
36 do hereby commend the life and memory of Charles Edward Taylor,
37 the world's first airplane mechanic, and recognize May 24 of each
38 year as Aviation Maintenance Technician Day in his honor.
