- 5 Basketball Team and their fans celebrated after winning the
- 6 Mississippi Private School Association's (MPSA) Overall Tournament
- 7 Title with a 72-67 victory over Leake Academy on Saturday,
- 8 February 28, 2004, at A.E. Wood Coliseum in Clinton; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the large gold basketball trophy, in the middle of a
- 10 sea of blue, was hoisted high by the team as they received the
