HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 108

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE GAMMAOMICRON CHAPTER
2 OF ALPHA KAPPA ALPHA SORORITY, INC., AND DECLARING APRIL 23, 2004,
3 AS GAMMAOMICRON CHAPTER - ALPHA KAPPA ALPHA SORORITY, INC., DAY.
