HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 115

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE
 2 PURPOSE OF REQUESTING THE DRAFTING, AND THE INTRODUCTION,
 3 CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE, OF A BILL ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND
 4 SECTION 11-11-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE VENUE IN
 5 GENERAL CIVIL ACTIONS; TO AMEND SECTION 11-1-63, MISSISSIPPI CODE
 6 OF 1972, TO MODIFY LIABILITY FOR LATENT DEFECTS; TO AMEND SECTION
 7 11-1-66, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE IMMUNITY OF
 8 PREMISES OWNERS FROM CIVIL LIABILITY; TO AMEND SECTION 85-5-7,
 9 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE JOINT AND SEVERAL LIABILITY
 10 FOR DAMAGES CAUSED BY MORE THAN ONE PERSON; TO AMEND SECTION

 15 PROTECTION FOR JURY PARTICIPATION; TO AMEND SECTION 25-7-61,
 16 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CREATE AND EXPAND THE TRIAL FUND; TO
 17 AMEND SECTION 33-1-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO MODIFY
 18 EXEMPTIONS FOR JURORS; TO AMEND SECTIONS 41-17-7 AND 47-5-55,
 19 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM TO THE PRECEDING SECTIONS; TO
 20 CREATE A MEDICAL REVIEW PANEL AND THE PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED BY
 21 THE PANEL; TO PROVIDE COMPENSATION FOR THE PANEL; TO PROVIDE A
 22 PROCESS TO DETERMINE WHO SHALL PAY CERTAIN ATTORNEY FEES; AND FOR
 23 RELATED PURPOSES."

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE
 25 OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, That the Joint
 26 Rules of the House and the Senate, including all the deadlines and
 27 other provisions imposed by Joint Rule No. 40, are suspended for
 28 the purpose of requesting the drafting, and the introduction,
 29 consideration and passage, of a bill entitled "AN ACT TO AMEND
 30 SECTION 1-11-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE VENUE IN
 31 GENERAL CIVIL ACTIONS; TO AMEND SECTION 11-1-63, MISSISSIPPI CODE
 32 OF 1972, TO MODIFY LIABILITY FOR LATENT DEFECTS; TO AMEND SECTION
 33 11-1-66, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE IMMUNITY OF
 34 PREMISES OWNERS FROM CIVIL LIABILITY; TO AMEND SECTION 85-5-7,
 35 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE JOINT AND SEVERAL LIABILITY
 36 FOR DAMAGES CAUSED BY MORE THAN ONE PERSON; TO AMEND SECTION
