HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 118

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING GORDON WITHMOND FELLOWS ON
2 BEING ELECTED THE 87TH ASSOCIATED STUDENT BODY PRESIDENT AT THE
3 UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI.

4 WHEREAS, Gordon Withmond Fellows, a Junior International
5 Studies Major from Tupelo, Mississippi, was elected as the 87th
6 Associated Student Body (ASB) President at the University of
7 Mississippi on February 17, 2004, and inaugurated on March 31; and

8 WHEREAS, before serving as ASB President, Gordon was an ASB
9 Senator from Kincannon Hall and the School of Liberal Arts, in
10 addition to serving on the ASB Cabinet for the 2002-2003 academic
11 year; and

12 WHEREAS, prior to becoming ASB President-elect, Gordon was
13 recently elected ASB Senator of the Year; and

14 WHEREAS, Gordon's activities outside of the ASB include
15 serving as Risk Reduction Manager and Alumni Relations Chairman
16 for Sigma Nu Fraternity; and

17 WHEREAS, also a member of the University of Mississippi
18 Forensics team, he has won the Superior Speaker Award at the
19 DSR-TKA National Student Congress Championships twice; and

20 WHEREAS, active in all aspects of the university, Gordon is a
21 member of various honor societies, including Lambda Sigma, Order
22 of Omega, Mortar Board and Omicron Delta Kappa; and

23 WHEREAS, over the next year as ASB President, Gordon will
24 work to improve transportation issues, extend wireless Internet
25 and lower the costs of textbooks; and

26 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
27 and commend the accomplishments of our state's upcoming leaders

28 and ambassadors, as evidenced by the successes of the young and
29 talented Gordon Fellows:
