HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 127

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE 2004 REGULAR SESSION OF 1 THE LEGISLATURE, AND SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE PURPOSE OF 2 3 PERMITTING THE FURTHER CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE OF CERTAIN 4 APPROPRIATION BILLS AND REVENUE BILLS THAT DIED AT THE DEADLINE FOR FINAL ADOPTION OF CONFERENCE REPORTS ON APPROPRIATION AND 5 б REVENUE BILL ON MONDAY, MAY 3, 2004.

WHEREAS, Section 36, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, provides that the House of Representatives, by resolution with the 8 Senate concurring therein, and by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of those 9 10 present and voting in each house, may extend a regular session of the Legislature for a period of thirty (30) days; and 11

WHEREAS, certain appropriation bills for general fund 12 agencies and certain revenue bills died at the deadline for final 13 14 adoption of conference reports on appropriation and revenue bills on Monday, May 3, 2004, and the Legislature needs the opportunity 15 to further consider those appropriation and revenue bills before 16 17 the end of the 2004 Regular Session:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF 18 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING 19 20 THEREIN, That the 2004 Regular Session of the Legislature is extended for a period of thirty (30) days from the final day of 21 22 the one hundred twenty-five (125) calendar days of the 2004 Regular Session of the Legislature, under the provisions of 23 24 Section 36, Mississippi Constitution of 1890.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Joint Rules of the House of Representatives and the Senate of the Mississippi State 26 27 Legislature, including all the deadlines and other provisions imposed by Joint Rule No. 40, are suspended for the purpose of 28 permitting the further consideration and passage of: 29 *HR40/R2361* H.
