HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 127  
(As Adopted by the House)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE 2004 REGULAR SESSION OF  
2 THE LEGISLATURE, AND SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE PURPOSE OF  
3 PERMITTING THE FURTHER CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE OF CERTAIN  
4 APPROPRIATION BILLS AND REVENUE BILLS THAT DIED AT THE DEADLINE  
5 FOR FINAL ADOPTION OF CONFERENCE REPORTS ON APPROPRIATION AND  
6 REVENUE BILLS ON MONDAY, MAY 3, 2004.

7 WHEREAS, Section 36, Mississippi Constitution of 1890,  
8 provides that the House of Representatives, by resolution with the  
9 Senate concurring therein, and by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of those  
10 present and voting in each house, may extend a regular session of  
11 the Legislature for a period of thirty (30) days; and

12 WHEREAS, certain appropriation bills for general and special  
13 fund agencies and certain revenue bills died at the deadline for  
14 final adoption of conference reports on appropriation and revenue  
15 bills on Monday, May 3, 2004, and the Legislature needs the  
16 opportunity to further consider those appropriation and revenue  
17 bills before the end of the 2004 Regular Session:

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
19 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING  
20 THEREIN, That the 2004 Regular Session of the Legislature is  
21 extended for a period of thirty (30) days from the final day of  
22 the one hundred twenty-five (125) calendar days of the 2004  
23 Regular Session of the Legislature, under the provisions of  
24 Section 36, Mississippi Constitution of 1890.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Joint Rules of the House of  
26 Representatives and the Senate of the Mississippi State  
27 Legislature, including all the deadlines and other provisions  
28 imposed by Joint Rule No. 40, are suspended for the purpose of  
29 permitting the further consideration and passage of:

30           (1) All appropriation bills for general and special fund  
31 agencies that died at the deadline for final adoption of  
32 appropriation and revenue bills on Monday, May 3, 2004; and

33           (2) The following revenue bills that died at the deadline  
34 for final adoption of appropriation and revenue bills on Monday,  
35 May 3, 2004: House Bill Nos. 973, 1791, 1792 and 1798, and Senate  
36 Bill Nos. 2809, 3088 and 3178.
