HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 127
(As Adopted by the House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE 2004 REGULAR SESSION OF
2 THE LEGISLATURE, SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE PURPOSE OF
3 PERMITTING THE FURTHER CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE OF CERTAIN
4 APPROPRIATION BILLS, REVENUE BILLS AND GENERAL BILLS THAT DIED AT
5 THE DEADLINE ON MONDAY, MAY 3, 2004, AND FIXING THE DATE OF SINE
6 DIE ADJOURNMENT OF THE 2004 REGULAR SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
8 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
9 THEREIN, That the 2004 Regular Session of the Legislature is
10 extended for a period of thirty (30) days from the final day of
11 the one hundred twenty-five (125) calendar days of the 2004
12 Regular Session of the Legislature, under the provisions of
13 Section 36, Mississippi Constitution of 1890.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Joint Rules of the House of
15 Representatives and the Senate of the Mississippi State
16 Legislature, including all the deadlines and other provisions
17 imposed by Joint Rule No. 40, are suspended for the purpose of
18 permitting the further consideration and passage of:

19 (1) All appropriation bills for general and special fund
20 agencies that died at the deadline for final adoption of
21 appropriation and revenue bills on Monday, May 3, 2004; and

22 (2) The following revenue and general bills that died at the
23 deadline for final adoption of appropriation and revenue bills,
24 and the deadline for conference reports on general bills to be
25 filed, on Monday, May 3, 2004: House Bill Nos. 1279, 1434, 1464,
26 1569, 1617, 1791, 1792 and 1798, and Senate Bill Nos. 2436, 2617,
27 2661, 2678, 2763, 2809, 2841, 3038, 3088 and 3178.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the 2004 Regular Session of the
29 Legislature will stand adjourned Sine Die at 6:00 p.m., Friday,
30 May 14, 2004.
