## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 17 (As Adopted by the House)

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE OBSERVANCE OF LYMPHEDEMA D-DAY 1 2 ON MARCH 6, 2004, IN MISSISSIPPI. 3 WHEREAS, lymphedema is an accumulation of lymphatic fluid 4 that causes swelling in the arms, legs, or other areas of the body and affects both men and women; and 5 WHEREAS, the swelling caused by lymphedema can lead to severe 6 infection or loss of the use of limbs, and patients suffering from 7 8 lymphedema must endure physical discomfort and disfigurement and 9 cope with the distress caused by these symptoms; and WHEREAS, the single largest group of people who get 10 lymphedema are cancer patients, including breast, prostate, 11 gynecological, head, neck, lung, sarcoma and melanoma patients; 12 13 and WHEREAS, recent studies have indicated that twenty percent of 14 15 breast cancer patients will get lymphedema after surgery and radiation; and 16 WHEREAS, according to the National Cancer Institute, there 17 are a reported 8.5 million Americans living after a diagnosis of 18 cancer, of which about two million are breast cancer survivors; 19 20 and WHEREAS, no drug or effective surgical treatment for 21 22 lymphedema currently exists; and 23 WHEREAS, research in all areas of lymphedema has been notably limited; and 24 25 WHEREAS, lymphedema, which has no cure and can occur anytime, 26 has severe financial, physical and psychological impacts on 27 patients; and \*HR40/R1146AH\* H.
