HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 20

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION FOR 1 SPONSORING THE "GO RED FOR WOMEN" CAMPAIGN TO PROMOTE WOMEN'S 2 3 HEALTH IN THE FIGHT AGAINST CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE. 4 WHEREAS, there are 1.5 million women residing in the State of Mississippi and cardiovascular disease is the leading cause of 5 death for women; and 6 7 WHEREAS, cardiovascular disease causes more than 5,200 women 8 to die in Mississippi each year; and WHEREAS, in addition to cardiovascular disease, almost 1,200 9 women die from stroke annually; and 10 WHEREAS, although one in three women die of heart disease and 11 one in five females have some form of heart or blood vessel 12 13 disease, only about a third of women know that heart disease is the leading cause of death for women; and 14 15 WHEREAS, women over the age of fifty-five are at a higher 16 risk for high blood pressure than men; and WHEREAS, fifty-four percent of women in Mississippi are 17 18 overweight or obese which are leading risk factors for cardiovascular disease; and 19 20 WHEREAS, because all women need to ask their doctor about 21 their risk of heart disease and stroke, the American Heart 22 Association invites women to take charge of their health by making 23 it a top priority; and WHEREAS, to encourage women to live a stronger, longer, 24 healthier life, the American Heart Association sponsors the "Go 25 26 Red for Women" campaign to fight cardiovascular disease in women:
