4	WHEREAS, a twenty-four-year veteran of the Mississippi
5	Highway Patrol (MHP), Lieutenant Philip Hemphill has rendered
6	honorable and commendable services to the State of Mississippi;

8	WHEREAS, since 1985, Lieutenant Hemphill has been a member of
9	MHP Pistol Team, and from that time until the present he has
10	brought great pride and honor to the state; and
11	WHEREAS, as a member of the MHP Pistol Team, Lieutenant
12	Hemphill won his first title as National Police Shooting Champion
13	in 1988, and subsequently added five more championship titles to
14	his growing list of awards in 1990, 1993, 1995, 1996 and 2003; and
15	WHEREAS, Lieutenant Hemphill shot his first perfect score of
16	1500 in 1995 and again in 2001, to become one of only two persons
17	to have earned a perfect score, the other officer being Sergeant
18	James Collins from Alabama; and
19	WHEREAS, at this year's national competitions, Lieutenant
20	Hemphill won the Semi-Auto Distinguished Match by setting a new
21	record. At the 2003 National Action Pistol Championship, he
22	placed third over-all out of a field of approximately 200 shooters
23	from all over the world, including Japan, Australia, Italy, Great
24	Britain, Germany, Switzerland and the Czech Republic; and
25	WHEREAS, as a member of the MHP Pistol Team, which has a long
26	and rich history of winning as well, including the four-man team

29	travel to Germany as a shooting instructor and competitor; and
