- 17 1954, to be married at the age of 17, with their parents
- 18 permission, by Reverend Mack Jones; and
- 19 WHEREAS, to their loving union, James Keith Nix was born in
- 20 1957 and Sandra Ruth Nix was born in 1960; and
- 21 WHEREAS, throughout 50 years of marriage, they have been
- 22 involved in the community through various clubs and city
- 23 government roles; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Jimmy's community involvement includes organizing
- 25 Bay Springs' first fire department, serving as chief for more than
- 26 20 years and also serving for many years as alderman and mayor pro
- 27 tem, and Betty Sue has spent many hours working with Bay Springs

- 28 beautification projects, the Bay Springs Garden Club and Bible
- 29 Study classes, but has been mainly "behind the scenes" supporting
- 30 Jimmy in his community endeavors; and
- 31 WHEREAS, their union has been blessed through fellowship and
