17	University, Coach Erves was offered the opportunity to become a
18	free agent with the Dallas Cowboys football organization, but
19	after careful consideration, decided to return home and accept a
20	job coaching; and
21	WHEREAS, at the commencement of his teaching career in 1976,
22	Coach Erves began as an instructor of industrial arts and
23	assistant eighth-grade football coach, but very quickly broadened
24	his curriculum to include teaching Tech Prep and Technology
25	Discovery, as well as rising in rank in the coaching arena; and
26	WHEREAS, while serving as an eighth-grade head coach, Coach
27	Erves went undefeated, and his total coaching career boasts an
28	impressive record of 235 wins and 87 losses; and
