- 49 friend, PFC Mabry will be sorely missed by those who experienced
- the depth of his love, commitment and compassion for life and the 50
- pursuit of freedom for all, but the legacy of his memory will 51
- 52 forever be etched in the hearts and memories of his survivors,
- 53 including: his father, Louis Mabry, Jr.; mother, Nancy Carter;
