1	A RESOLUTION COMMENDING REVEREND DR. HORACE L. BUCKLEY ON THE
2	CELEBRATION OF HIS 35TH ANNIVERSARY AS PASTOR OF CADE CHAPEL
3	MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH.

- 12 WHEREAS, having received his bachelor of science degree from
- 13 Mississippi Valley State University, Dr. Buckley furthered his
- 14 educational career by attending Tuskegee Institute, where he
- 15 obtained his master of education degree, and his doctor of
- 16 divinity degree (Honoris, Causa) from both Natchez College and the
- 17 Mississippi Baptist Seminary; and
- 18 WHEREAS, men of faith such as Dr. Buckley are rare in these
- 19 times of social and moral decline in America but nevertheless
- 20 serve to uphold everything that is good and right about this
- 21 country as examples to every other citizen of what this nation is
- 22 capable of being when spiritual foundation is built on faith in
- 23 God; and
- 24 WHEREAS, under the leadership of Dr. Buckley, Cade Chapel
- 25 constructed a \$1.2 million Family Life Center, which houses an
- 26 array of ministries and serves the community where the church is
- 27 located; and

- WHEREAS, Dr. Buckley served in the House of Representatives
- 29 from 1976-1991, representing House District 70, and serving on the
- 30 committees for Apportionment and Elections, Education, Judiciary
- 31 B, Penitentiary, Appropriations, Executive Contingent Funds, and
- 32 Local and Private Legislation; and
- 33 WHEREAS, an active member of many community and religious
- 34 organizations, including the Jackson District Association, board
- 35 member of the General Missionary Baptist State Convention and
- 36 Assistant General Secretary of the National Baptist Convention,
- 37 USA, Inc.; and
- 38 WHEREAS, Dr. Buckley has been lovingly supported in all his
- 39 endeavors by his faithful wife, the former Myra Beamon; their four
- 40 children, Horace, Carol LaJune, Cedric and Reginald; and five
- 41 grandchildren; and
- WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
- 43 recognize such outstanding Godly leaders as Dr. Buckley, who has
- 44 dedicated his long and distinguished career to bringing many souls
- 45 to know Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior:

- 47 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby
