9	air, celebrated its 92nd anniversary on March 12, 2004; and
10	WHEREAS, personally funding the newly formed organization,
11	Daisy sold her extremely valuable necklace of rare matched pearls
12	to ensure the continued operation of the circle which very rapidly
13	grew in respect, as many talented and educated women and girls
14	sought an outlet to expound on their abilities; and
15	WHEREAS, Girl Scouts is the world's preeminent organization
16	dedicated solely to girls where, in an accepting and nurturing
17	environment, girls build character and skills for success in the
18	real world; and
19	WHEREAS, in partnership with committed adults, Girl Scouts
20	develop qualities that will serve its members all their lives,
21	including strong values, social conscience and conviction about
22	their own potential and self-worth; and
23	WHEREAS, the Girl Scouts of the USA chartered the Girl Scout
