- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** A business may not authorize or require the use
- 9 of a nonoriginal equipment manufacturer after-market crash part on
- 10 any motor vehicle without first obtaining the written consent of
- 11 the owner of the motor vehicle at the time of repair
- 12 authorization, verifiable by the owner's signature on a separate
- 13 consent form prepared by the Attorney General's Office of Consumer
- 14 Protection.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** Section 1 of this act shall be codified within
- 16 Chapter 27 of Title 63, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 17 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2004.
