## SENATE BILL NO. 2075

1 2 3 4 5	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-56, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL TO USE A REMOVABLE WINDSHIELD PLACARD TO PARK IN AN AREA SET ASIDE FOR THE DISABLED UNLESS THE DATE OF EXPIRATION OF THE PLACARD IS VISIBLE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
8	amended as follows:
9	27-19-56. (1) Upon application by any legal resident of the
10	State of Mississippi with a disability which limits or impairs the
11	ability to walk, the State Tax Commission shall prepare and issue
12	through the county tax collectors a special license plate bearing
13	the International Symbol of Access adopted by Rehabilitation
14	International in 1969 at its Eleventh World Congress on
15	Rehabilitation of the Disabled for not more than one (1) vehicle
16	that is registered in the applicant's name. The initial
17	application shall be accompanied by the certification of a
18	licensed physician that (a) the applicant meets the definition of
19	persons with disabilities which limit or impair the ability to
20	walk; and (b) that the physician has determined that the applicant
21	will have the disability for at least five (5) years. The State
22	Tax Commission shall prepare and issue to the tax collectors of
23	the various counties, decals for placement on the special license
24	plates. The decals shall bear thereon the month in which the
25	license plate was issued and the year in which the special license
26	plate will expire. The special license plate issued under this
27	section is valid for the period of time that the license tag

attached upon a motor vehicle is issued pursuant to Section

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- 29 27-19-31(1). A person to whom the special license plate is issued
- 30 may retain the special license plate and may renew it by
- 31 submitting to the county tax collector, on or before its
- 32 expiration, the certification of a licensed physician that the
- 33 physician has determined (a) that the applicant meets the
- 34 definition of a person with a disability which limits or impairs
- 35 the ability to walk; and (b) that the applicant will have the
- 36 disability for at least five (5) years. If an applicant fails to
- 37 renew the special license plate before its date of expiration,
- 38 then he shall surrender the special license plate to the county
- 39 tax collector and the tax collector shall issue to such person a
- 40 regular license plate to replace the special license plate.
- The terms "vehicle" and "motor vehicle," as used in this
- 42 section, includes motorcycles.
- The term "persons with disabilities which limit or impair the
- 44 ability to walk" when used in this section means those persons
- 45 who, as determined by a licensed physician:
- 46 (a) Cannot walk two hundred (200) feet without stopping
- 47 to rest; or
- (b) Cannot walk without the use of, or assistance from,
- 49 a brace, cane, crutch, another person, prosthetic device,
- 50 wheelchair, or other assistive device; or
- 51 (c) Are restricted by lung disease to such an extent
- 52 that the person's forced (respiratory) expiratory volume for one
- 53 (1) second, when measured by spirometry, is less than one (1)
- 54 liter, or the arterial oxygen tension is less than sixty (60)
- 55 mm/hg on room air at rest; or
- (d) Use portable oxygen; or
- (e) Have a cardiac condition to the extent that the
- 58 person's functional limitations are classified in severity as
- 59 Class III or Class IV according to standards set by the American
- 60 Heart Association; or

61 (f) Are severely limited in their ability to walk due 62 to an arthritic, neurological or orthopedic condition.

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An applicant for a special license plate bearing the International Symbol of Access shall not be required to pay any fee or charge for the issuance of such license plate separate from or in addition to the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees otherwise required by law to be paid for the issuance of a regular license plate for such vehicle.

- The State Tax Commission shall prepare removable (2) windshield placards and such placards shall be issued and periodically renewed upon the applications of persons with disabilities which limit or impair the ability to walk. placards shall be issued, free of charge, to applicants through the offices of the tax collectors of the counties. The initial application shall be accompanied by the certification of a licensed physician that the applicant meets the definition of persons with disabilities which limit or impair the ability to These placards shall be valid for the period of time that the license tag attached upon a motor vehicle is issued pursuant to Section 27-19-31(1) and may be renewed in the same manner as provided for the renewal of the special license plates under subsection (1) of this section. The removable windshield placard must be displayed on the left side of the vehicle dashboard or by hanging it on the rearview mirror of the vehicle. The State Tax

Temporary removable windshield placards authorized by this subsection shall be prepared by the State Tax Commission and shall be issued, free of charge, to applicants through the offices of the tax collectors of the counties. 94 certification of a licensed physician that the applicant meets the 95 definition of persons with disabilities which limit or impair the 96 ability to walk. The certification shall also include the period 97 of time that the physician determines the applicant will have the 98 disability, not to exceed six (6) months. The temporary removable 99 windshield placard must be displayed on the left side of the 100 vehicle dashboard or by hanging it on the rearview mirror of the vehicle. The temporary removable windshield placard shall be 101 102 valid for a period of time for which the physician has determined that the applicant will have the disability, not to exceed six (6) 103 104 months from the date of issuance. The State Tax Commission shall prescribe the placement for motorcycles. 105

- 106 (4) The removable windshield placard and the temporary
  107 removable windshield placard shall be two-sided and shall include:
- (a) The International Symbol of Access, which is at least three (3) inches in height, centered on the placard (the color of the removable windshield placard shall be white on a blue shield; and the temporary removable windshield placard shall be white on a red shield);
- 113 (b) An identification number and, on the reverse side, 114 the name of the individual to whom the placard is issued;
- 115 (c) A date of expiration; and
- 116 (d) The seal of the State of Mississippi.
- (5) 117 (a) It shall be unlawful to park a motor vehicle in an 118 area set aside for persons who are disabled if the motor vehicle does not (i) have displayed the removable windshield placard 119 120 authorized in this section with the date of expiration visible, (ii) have the special license plate issued under this section 121 properly displayed upon the motor vehicle, or (iii) have the 122 123 disabled American veteran tag or plate issued under Section 124 27-19-53 properly displayed upon the motor vehicle. Any person 125 who unlawfully parks a motor vehicle in such areas, or who blocks 126 such spaces or access thereto, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor

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and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than Two
Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each such violation. For the third
and subsequent offenses under this section, the offender's
driver's license shall be suspended for ninety (90) days by the
Commissioner of Public Safety in accordance with Section 63-1-53

in addition to any fine imposed. The court shall not suspend or

133 reduce any fine required to be imposed under this subsection.

(b) A person who is charged with a violation of this section by parking a motor vehicle in an area set aside for persons who are disabled and failing properly to display (i) a removable windshield placard on the dash of the vehicle or by hanging it on the rearview mirror of the vehicle, (ii) a special license plate issued under this section upon the vehicle or (iii) a disabled American veteran tag or plate issued under Section 27-19-53 upon the vehicle shall not be convicted and shall have the charge dismissed upon presentation to the court of proof by means of sworn oral testimony or sworn affidavit that at the time of the charged violation he or a passenger in the vehicle possessed a valid removable windshield placard issued under this

- (6) Any person who, for the purpose of obtaining a special license plate or windshield placard under this section, files with the county tax collector a physician's certification, knowing the certification to be false or to have been fraudulently obtained, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).
- 153 (7) All law enforcement officers are authorized to enforce
  154 this section on public and private property. Provision of spaces
  155 restricted to handicapped parking and proper marking of such
  156 spaces shall be considered as intent and permission to enforce
  157 such designated parking on private property. Any owner of private
  158 property may tow away a vehicle that is parked on the owner's
  159 private property in violation of the disabled parking restrictions
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section.

- 160 set forth in this section at the vehicle owner's expense. In
- 161 addition, the vehicle owner may be subject to any fines or other
- 162 penalties provided in this section. Only areas marked in
- 163 accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility
- 164 Guidelines or equivalent standards shall be enforced. Spaces
- 165 shall bear the International Symbol of Access.
- 166 (8) Motor vehicles displaying a special license plate,
- 167 license plate decal, placard or parking certificate or permit
- 168 bearing the International Symbol of Access issued to a person with
- 169 a disability by any other state or district subject to the laws of
- 170 the United States shall be allowed the special parking privileges
- 171 under this section provided the license plate, decal, placard,
- 172 permit or certificate bears the International Symbol of Access and
- 173 is displayed in a prominent place on the vehicle.
- 174 (9) Parking in any area set aside for persons who are
- 175 disabled is limited to vehicles which, immediately before or after
- 176 the utilization of such an area, are used to transport a person
- 177 with a disability which limits or impairs the ability to walk.
- 178 The identification required to park in such an area, except as
- 179 provided in subsection (8) of this section, is as follows:
- 180 (a) For a vehicle used to transport a person with a
- 181 permanent disability, that person's permanent windshield placard
- 182 must be displayed or the vehicle must have a special license tag
- issued under this section or Section 27-19-53 properly displayed.
- (b) For a vehicle being used by a person who has a
- 185 temporary disability which limits or impairs the ability to walk,
- 186 or which is being used to transport such a person, a temporary
- 187 windshield placard must be displayed.
- Any person who parks in an area set aside for persons who are
- 189 disabled in violation of this subsection shall be punished as
- 190 provided for in subsection (5) of this section.
- 191 (10) Upon application by a nursing home, retirement home or
- 192 other institution that transports disabled persons, the State Tax

- 193 Commission may issue the special license plate authorized pursuant
- 194 to this section for not more than one (1) vehicle that is
- 195 registered in the applicant's name that is used to transport
- 196 disabled residents of the institution. Such institution shall
- 197 comply with all other laws regarding the registration of such
- 198 vehicle.
- 199 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 200 and after its passage.
